NOTIFICATION

In terms of clause 17 of this deptt. Memo No.797-F(MED) dt.31/01/2011 in case of death of a WBHS enrolled Govt. Employee / Govt. Pensioner in an Empanelled Private Health Care Organisation during the indoor treatment , the concerned HCO shall release the dead body and send the unsettled treatment bills , if any, to the concerned department and the department concerned shall take necessary steps for payment of hospital dues.

But it has been observed that a huge amount of outstanding bills of some HCOs are pending with different departments for payment which causes hindrance in implementing the aforesaid clause.

Under this circumstances , the under signed is directed by the order of the Governor to say that Governor is pleased to modify the provisions of Clause 17 of clause 17 of this deptt. Memo No.797-F(MED) dt.31/01/2011 in the following manner :-

" In case of death of a WBHS enrolled Govt. Employee / Govt. Pensioner in an Empanelled Private Health Care Organisation , the cocernen HCO may send the unsettled treatment bills , if any , directly to Medical Cell , Finance (Audit) Deptt , Writers' Buildings , Kolkata 700001 instead of existing provision of sending the same to the department from where the deceased enrolled. The Medical Cell Of The Finance Department will examine the claim and calculate the admissible amount as per provisions of WBHS-2008. Thereafter refer the same to the concerned department for payment to the respective HCO , from the relevant head of account.

This will take effect from the date of issuance of this Notification.
