Sub: Caution Notice

Many serious allegations like excess billing over WBHS rate, refusal of cashless treatment, forcing to deposit cash before admission of patient, misbehavior with patients have been reported to this cell against your hospital. Several meetings have been taken place at the Medical Cell with the officials of your organization and entrusted officers of West Bengal Health Scheme (WBHS) in this regard but all the efforts were in vain. Even in this **Covid Pandemic period** your hospital continues to claim exaggerated amount for cashless as well as reimbursement treatment.

It is very astonishing that in many cases this cell released less than 50% of your claim for cashless treatment. But you never ask the cause of such deduction. It proves that the allegation of overbilling, charged against your hospital is not fake.

In view of the above, you are hereby cautioned to mend yourself and to abstain from doing such malpractices **immediately** otherwise you will be liable for **de-empement** of your organisation from WBHS without any prior notice.
